

TUFUX ENTERTAINMENT TO DEVELOPE GRITTY FEATURE FILM

NEW YORK, NY. - October 3, 2010 - Tufux Entertainment partner Larry Strong has agreed to develop "Cope", an ultra-dark cop drama set in the violent urban streets of Detroit. The screenplay is being penned by Damian Voerg, a New York based filmmaker. They are currently in negotiations to secure financing for the project.

Larry Strong is the producer of the current independent hit feature film, "Last Day of Summer" starring Nikki Reed (Twilight) and DJ Qualls (Memphis Beat).
